

From the Director

The year started very well with the opening of our branch library in its new location – on the Leggett Campus adjacent to the Waterford Senior Center. At four times the floor space of our previous location we can offer a greater range of services, including Internet access. An afternoon story time and craft program was offered here in the fall as well. Use has steadily increased over the year.


With the relocation of our branch library we also rolled out Express Checkout service. Patrons can use this station to checkout their own materials. The Leggett Branch served as the pilot project for developing this service. By mid-summer we were able to offer it at Main as well. The use of this service counts for about 30%, on average, of our total circulation.

A companion component of the Express Checkout service is the implementation of Radio Frequency ID tags to track the Library's stock of materials. The computer chip on each tag is linked to the item record. Reader pads can scan a stack of materials for checkout as opposed to scanning each item's barcode. Staff made a concerted effort, with help from members of the Friends of the Library, to complete tagging our collection of 130,000+ items at Main in 6 months.

Service developments this year also included 24/7 Automated Phone Renewal. Patrons can call our 800-number to renew items over the phone at any time, day or night.






