



From the Director

Our community is using the library in greater numbers than ever. Visits to Main averaged 700 per month and traffic at Leggett Branch averaged 120 visits. We had an average of 750 visitors per month to our website.

Visitors make use of a variety of services, not least of which is Internet access. The number of items being checked out from the collections is holding steady with Express Checkout accounting for 37% of monthly circulation transactions.

Attendance at programs for all ages is on the upswing. Our Children's Department now offers open attendance at storytime sessions to better meet the needs of parents with unpredictable schedules. Adults' Services continues to offer an increasing variety of quality programs.


A highlight this year was Waterford's selection as a site for the Michigan Notable Books author tour. Diane Maddex, author of *Alden B. Dow, Midwestern Modern* and Craig McDonald, Director of Alden B. Dow Home & Studio in Midland, Michigan spoke on Mr. Dow's contribution to American architecture of the 20th century.

Subscribers to our online newsletter have increased to 353. The Library joined the Waterford Area Chamber of Commerce and participated in the annual Expo. The Museum Adventure Pass program sponsored by Macy's has been popular. We circulated 1,723 of these passes offering free admission for 2-4 persons to museums and cultural centers in the metro area.

The Waterford School District upgraded their online system so that they are once again in alignment with the public library. The new software is also being used in a pilot project to track textbooks at Mott High School.






