



From the Director

We celebrated our 50th anniversary as a public library this year. Library staff developed an exceptional range of celebration events that included a birthday cake baking contest for adults and a birthday cake craft contest for children, a birthday bash featuring miniature golf inside the library and a concert by Top-per Most - Beatles tribute band, and our first every car show.

Throughout the year we hosted several photo sessions with local award-winning photographer, Mari La-tozas, which provided our Birthday Photo Album featuring our patrons.

The year was also marked by significant loss. Evelyn Seeterlin, charter member of the Friends of the Waterford Library and a driving force behind establishing the Library, succumbed to a long illness. Gerri Pridmore, Library Advisory Board Trustee, passed away suddenly.

Revenues from our dedicated millage increased slightly. We hope it is the beginning of a trend as the economy improves. Resources are focused on rebuilding the collection. Econtent materials, e.g. books, magazines and audiobooks, are more popular than ever and we are working to meet the demand.

Our highly-credentialed staff, along with well-developed collections and well-maintained public access workstations, continue to be the sturdy foundations for library services in Waterford. Staff development included the promotion of Jon Deahl from Circulation Clerk to Circulation Services Coordinator.
